

Sant Jagatmata who met Holy Highness Sadguru Atma Malik in Karadaga (a village in the state of Karnataka) in the year 1971. Since then until 15 August, 2018 for 48 years, Sant Jagatmata practised renunciation and austerity along with long time meditation in the holy presence of Sadguru Atma Malik. She also went through various types of Anushthan and Panchagni rituals from beginning till the end. Her identity was known for the strongest saint of the Vishwatmak family. Sant Jagatmata (who was also called as Mai) gave a lot of love to all the peoples in the ashram, and she took care of all the sannyasins like a mother and got completely one with Sadguru at 2.30 am in the early morning on 16th August, 2018. Before this, an accident took place on 11th August 2018 in which Sant Jagatmata was caught in fire and got severely burnt. She had spent 5 days in this illness. According to Sadguru Atma Malik, These accidents and sickness are the results of our past Karmas and Sant Jagatmata wished to finish them in this very life in the presence of her Sadguru. In that five days, Sadguru Atma Malik Mauli was meeting her very often as he knew what was going to happen . In the last minutes of her life, she asked the nearby sannyasins that "Tomorrow morning offer Puranpoli Prasad (an Indian sweet) for all people in ashram" and then left the body at 2.25 am as if she knew her time of death and so her death should not cause sadness but become a happy ceremony that her life is now liberated. According to her wish, on 16th August 2018 all the school children and devotees of all the ashrams were offered Puranpoli Mahaprasad.

The history of many saints like Ramkrishna Paramahansa, Swami Vivekananda, Lord Krishna and many others completed the backlogs of past karmas and fulfilled the aim of their life. As like them, Sant Jagatmata has fulfilled the purpose of her birth and has been a successor of Amarpada (immortal stage). At the time of Agni Sanskar (cremation), Babaji said: Jagat Mata has abandoned the body, but her holy spirit (Atma) has remained in everyone of us.
